LACSD Signs with EnerTech Environmental to Convert Biosolids into Renewable Energy

ATLANTA, GEORGIA (July 19, 2006) – EnerTech Environmental announced today that it has signed a 20 year contract with the Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (LACSD) to convert their biosolids into renewable energy using EnerTech’s patented SlurryCarb™ process.

LACSD provides wastewater and solid waste management for over half of the population of Los Angeles County. The District’s service area covers approximately 800 square miles, which includes 78 cities. “Our region is one in which renewable energy is fast becoming a sought after commodity.
